Fund Requirements of Kittitas County/Explanation: Purpose of this fifth amendment to the delegation agreement is to increase the amount of revenue provided to KCPHD for the operation of its well delegation program, decrease the inspections for well decommissionings, and add a provision on conducting inspections while the driller is onsite.

Kittitas County Grant/Contract Application Amount: Fifth (5th) Amendment to the Ecology Agreement. reflects the following:

1. Grant amount will be increased by including 50% of the notification fees collected for water well decommissioning within Kittitas County during period covered by this agreement. **Effective date shall be July 23, 2005.**
2. KCPHD shall decrease inspections for well decommissionings in Kittitas County from 100% to 90% annually. **Effective date shall be date Ecology's Water Resource Program Manager signs agreement.** [Date inserted post execution is: February 21, 2007.]
3. Adds a new provision that requires KCPHD to, at a minimum, conduct 25% of all its inspections while driller is onsite. This percentage may be adjusted by the contract manager driller "no shows." **Effective date shall be date Ecology's Water Resource Program Manager signs agreement.** [Date inserted post execution is: February 21, 2007.]

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into by and between the Department of Ecology and Kittitas County Health Department (KCHD).

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the amount of revenue provided to KCHD for the operation of their well delegation program, decrease the inspections for well decommissionings, and add a provision on conducting inspections while the driller is onsite.

THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE THAT:

1. The grant amount of this agreement shall be increased by including fifty percent (50%) of the notification fees collected for water well decommissioning within Kittitas County during the time period covered by this agreement. The effective date of this amendment shall be July 23, 2005.
2. KCHD shall decrease inspections from One Hundred Percent (100%) to Ninety Percent (90%) annually of wells being decommissioned in Kittitas County. The effective date of this provision shall be the date Ecology's Water Resource Program Manager signs the agreement.
3. KCHD shall, at a minimum, conduct Twenty-five Percent (25%) of all their inspections while the driller is on-site. This percentage may be adjusted by the contract manager for driller "no shows". The effective date of this provision shall be the date Ecology's Water Resource Program Manager signs the agreement.
